Our Chaplain's Corner

Dear Catholic Daughters,

The month of November is a month of remembrances. We begin with the Feast of "All Saints." The Catechism of the Catholic Church explains a Saint is "The holy one who leads a life in union with God through the grace of Christ and receives the reward of eternal life." All of us are called to be Saints. The Church has declared members of the faithful, saints, for example, Mary the Mother of Our Lord and the Apostles. In our liturgical celebration we celebrate their feast day.

There are many unnamed saints. Children at baptism are without sin. Should they die, they are in the presence of God and therefore are saints. Many faithful who are never canonized, but lived their lives in union with God, are saints. In the Creed, we declare we believe in the communion of saints. Therefore, we celebrate the Saints the Church set before us as role models and intercessors. We celebrate Saints who have been part of our lives - our parents, grandparents, a family member, or a friend. St. Pope John Paul II tells us, "Let us look at the saints who are valiant witnesses of fidelity to Christ; let us be inspired by their example in climbing the mountain of holiness. Be Saints! This...is every believers calling."

On the day after the feast of All Saints, we celebrate All Souls Day by remembering all our family and friends that have gone before us.

The 11th of November is Veterans Day. This day is important because it reminds us to acknowledge the sacrifices of the men and women who have served or are currently serving in the armed forces of the United States.

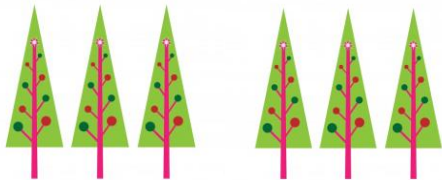
